### MISSIONAL MOVE: CREATE THE FUTURE INVITATION

We believe God has called Valley Creek Church to do five things in the next five years through Missional Move: Create the Future. A missional move is when someone takes their next step so someone else can take theirs.


- Prayer Center
- Training Center
- Argyle Campus
- University Campus
- 7 Continent Strategy

We're asking everyone to do three things to contribute:


- Commit to Valley Creek as your church
- Every person give above and beyond what you already give (sacrificially) over the next two years
- Take one next step every year for the next five years


## DISCUSS & ENGAGE THE SCRIPTURES

1. How did you experience God through the Commitment Weekend experience?


 *We worshipped, meditated on God's Word, declared "let there be," and took a next step of committing and picking up a pen to be part of the story. In all of this, God was present. Take time to unpack how your circle personally experienced God in a corporate setting. If "I don't know is spoken or there is uncertainty, share your experience as an example. Ask follow-up questions like, "What did you feel like in the worship center? What was easy or hard? What do you think God was showing you?"*

2. Read [Matthew 28:19-20](#). What is the Holy Spirit saying to you about the three ways to contribute to this missional move?

 *We've talked about this several times as a circle, but now it's time to move. As Circle Leaders, we want to keep these top-of-mind as we move forward. Maybe even ask these questions: "Which one are you excited about? Which one challenges you? What steps have you already taken? How are you arranging and rearranging your life to walk out these three things?"*

 *In your attendance, add notes on this question and summarize your circle experience.*

3. Read [Luke 17:14 \(AMP\)](#). What does God want to do in your life through this missional move?

 *Jesus already made a missional move for us, and now we get to follow His example. As we move, He'll do something in us as He does something through us. Follow-up questions could be, "What are you asking God for through this missional move? What do you want to see God do in you and your family? What have you already seen God do over the last few weeks?"*

**PRAY:** Take a few minutes to express gratitude to God for who He is and for our church as we start moving forward by faith to create the future.
